

The State of Alabama: This Indenture made and entered
 Shelby County 3 into this twenty ninth day of May
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and fifty between Thomas Johnson of the first part
 and Thomas J. Hand of the second part witnesseth
 that the party of the first part for and in Consideration

of the sum of two hundred and five dollars to him paid
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged hath this day
 bargained and sold and doth hereby bargain sell and
 convey to the party of the second part the following described
 tract of Land lying in said County to wit The west half
 of the South West quarter of section thirteen in Township
 twenty one of Range two west in the District of Land
 subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama containing twenty
 nine acres and eighty five hundredths of an acre
 To have and to hold the said tract of land to the party
 of the second part and his heirs and assigns forever
 And the said party of the first part doth hereby convey
 -ant with the party of the second part that he is lawfully
 seized of said Lands hath a right to sell the same and
 that he will warrant and defend the right to said land
 to the said party of the second and his heirs and assigns
 -s forever against the lawful claim or claims of all
 persons whatever for witness whereof the said party
 of the first part doth hereunto set his hand and seal
