 Squire Stail of the 2nd part Witness that the party of the 1st
 part for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred
 dollars to them in hand paid have given granted bargain
 and sold and by their consents do give grant bargain
 and sell to said Squire Stail all their right title and
 interest in and to the following land to wit North West
 quarter of section Twenty four Township twenty one
 Range one west which is an undivided moiety of
 said land To have and to hold the same to said

Squire Hail and his heirs forever and we do Covenant to
and with said Squire Hail that we have good right to
bargain and sell said moiety of said land aforesaid
and that we will forever warrant & defend titles to the
said Writup our hands and seals Lindsey Hail and
Nancy ^{his} Hail ~~and~~ ^{more}
