

Know all men by these presents that I George M Randall of Shelby County Alabama for and in Consideration of two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Harriet A Young wife of William Young the receipt of which I do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold and delivered to the said Harriet A Young in her own right the following property viz one Gray mare aged about fifteen years also one gray mare aged about seven years old also one gray horse Colt about three years old also one gray filly about three years old also one bay filly Colt about one year old to have and to hold the said above described horses to her the said Harriet A Young her heirs and assigns forever The said horses were unsold by the Sheriff of Shelby County as the property of William Young and purchased by me and are now sold to said Harriet by me for her own exclusive use and benefit She independent of her said husband having secured to me the payment of said sum of two hundred dollars Given under my hand and seal this 20th day of January A.D. 1857
