 -tween Willis Dilluse of the County & State aforesaid
 and William Moor of the same County withwitness
 that the said Willis Dilluse has this day bought of
 said William Moor a certain several Station called
 Six George about ten years of age for the sum of one
 hundred & fifty Dollars to be paid as follows to wit
 one hundred dollars to be paid the first day of
 January A.D. 1852 and fifty Dollars to be paid on the
 first day of January A.D. 1853 for which said sum
 the said Willis Dilluse has this day executed to said
 William Moor his promissory notes and the said
 Willis Dilluse has agreed and doth hereby mortgage
 to said William Moor the said Station & the proceeds
 of the present Spring season of said horse for the se-
 -curity of said purchase money and the said
 Willis Dilluse agree to collect the proceeds of said
 Spring season for said Moor to be paid over
 to said Moor towards the payment of said pur-
 -chase money the said Moor to have a lien on said

I said proceeds to have the right if he see proper to collect and appropriate said fees or proceeds to the payment of said purchase money to the amount which may at any time be due In Witness of which we have each set our hands and seals to this instrument on this the tenth day of March A.D. 1837
