 McFlanahan that the party of the 1st part is justly indebted
 to the 2nd party in the amount thereof several prom-
 issory notes and for thirty three dollars and for thirty
 five dollars and and for thirty eight & 3/100 dollars all
 bearing date herewith and due each day after
 date which said several debts said Porter is anxious &
 desirous to secure therefore for and in Consideration of
 the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the
 said McFlanahan the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged the said Porter has given granted con-
 veyed and sold & by these Presents does give grant
 bargain & sell to said McFlanahan the following prop-
 erty to wit One yoke of oxen and three quarters
 mignon and dark bay mule seven & to 10 years old
 to have and hold the same upon trust nevertheless
 the said Porter is to retain the possession of said
 Porter until said McFlanahan deems it expedient
 to collect his said debts then said McFlanahan may
 seize said property and after giving twenty day noti-
 ce by advertisement in three public places sell said
 property to the highest bidder for Cash and apply the
 same to the payment of said debts but should
 the same be fully paid this deed is void else to
 remain in full force Witness our hands & seals
