This indenture made and entered into between Alford McColdwill of the first part and Samuel Luper of the second part and John P West and Henry Sawyer of the third part witnesseth that the said party of the third part has become the security for the said party of the first part in the sum of about five hundred and twenty five dollars by executing with the said party of the first part a note to Elbert C Bowdon to that amount dated sometime about the 14 day of December 1850 now for and in Consideration of the said debt and for the further Consideration of one dollar to the said party of the first part in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said party of the first have sold and here by sell and convey to the said party of the second part the following described property to wit four head of horses to wit two bay horses black-tailed one bay mare and one gray horse all his house hold and Kitchen furniture ever and above such as is exempt by law to the use of each family in the state to have and to hold in trust as follows it is agreed that if the said Alford McColdwill shall fully pay said debt above described or otherwise release the said party of the first then this indenture to be null & otherwise it is agreed that in default of such payment or discharge the said party of the second part is hereby authorized to sell all of said property for cash to the highest bidder after giving thirty days notice by advertisement posted up at three public places in said County and out of the proceeds of said sale to pay said debt together with reasonable costs hereon given under our hands and seals this 13th day of March 1851
