 East also the S 1/4 of S E 1/4 Section No 11 Township No 23 Range
 No 14 East containing one hundred and twenty acres to
 have and to hold the afore granted premises with all
 and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging unto
 the said Thomas Collins his heirs and assigns to their
 use and behoof forever and we do Covenant with the
 said Thomas Collins his heirs and assigns to their use
 and behoof forever that we are lawfully seized in fee of
 said granted premises that they are free from all incum-
 brances that we have a good right to sell and
 convey the same to the said Thomas Collins and that
 we will warrant and defend the same to the said
 Thomas Collins his heirs and assigns forever against
 the lawful claims and demands in writing whereof
 we have set our hands and seals this 10th December 1849
