

Clark the State of Alabama } This Deed of Trust made this 28th day of
 to Shelly County April 1857 between Henry Clark the debtor
 Parties of the 1st part and Standcock Parties of the 2nd part Witnesseth
 that the said Parties is the security of the said Clark to John Baker
 Admr of Hugh McCornie dec in the sum of fifty eight dollars
 & to Joseph Brown in the sum of fifty dollars each of said debts
 may be a little more or less which said debts said Clark is ac-
 -ious and desirous to protect & indemnify said Parties there-
 -up therefore for and in consideration of the premises as well
 the sum of five dollars to him in hand paid by said Parties
 the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said Clark has
 given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do
 give grant bargain and sell to said Parties the following
 land to wit. S $\frac{1}{4}$ of N $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3 T 22 R 1 W to
 have and to hold the same forever and until default
 be made in the payment of the two debts aforesaid
 and until the said Parties about to be made to satisfy
 the said Parties may & shall advertise & sell said land
 in Columbusiana to the highest bidder for Cash 1st giving
 20 days notice of the time & place of said sale by public
 advertisement in at least three public places and out
 of said sale pay & satisfy said debts and the surplus
 if any pay over to said Clark but should said debts
 be fully paid by said Clark and said Parties hold harmless
 then this deed to be void else to remain in full force
