

The State of Alabama, This Indenture made the
 Shilley County, Twenty sixth day of April Eight
 -een hundred fifty and between William Moor
 of the first part & Lyman of the second part and
 Robert H. Meredith of the third part all of the State
 and County above named Mississippi That whereas
 the said William Moor is indebted to the said
 Robert H. Meredith in the sum of one hundred
 fifty six 45/100 dollars the same being a promissory
 note dated the 26th day of April eighteen hundred
 fifty and due one day after date & the said
 William Moor has bargained sold aliened and
 conveyed and by these presents doth bargain
 alien and convey unto the said H. Butler for
 and in consideration of the sum of five
 dollars of lawful money to the said William
 Moor the said H. Butler in have paid at
 and before the making and delivery of these
 presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 -edged The following described crops now

planted and growing To wit so much of my
 Crop of Corn now planted and growing as will
 make in good and lawful measure three
 hundred Bushels also so much of my Crop of
 Cotton now planted and growing as will make
 eight thousand pounds in the end both of
 which Crops are to be gathered and picked by
 the said William Moore & William Moore
 do for myself my heirs and assigns warrant
 and well we depend unto the said St Butler
 a good and lawful right to the Crops now
 planted and growing herein described against
 all and every person whatsoever in trust
 Notwithstanding should the said William Moore pay or
 cause to be paid to the said Robert H. Menduth the note
 herein described on or before the first day of December next
 then this obligation to be void and of no effect but should
 the said William Moore fail to pay the same on or before
 the first day of December next in that case the said St Butler
 may proceed to sell the Crops herein described at the
 house where the said William Moore now lives first
 giving fifteen days notice and then the said St But-
 ler shall apply the proceeds to the payment of the note
 herein described and if there should remain a balance
 in the hands of the said St Butler arising from the sale
 of the within described Crops after paying the within
 described note then the said St Butler shall pay
 the balance over to the said William Moore after
 paying the expenses of carrying this trust into effect
 Given under my hand and seal this 26th day
