To all to whom these Presents shall come Greeting
Whereas Edmund King of Shelby County has deposited with
the Secretary of the Board of Trustees of the University of
Alabama a Certificate of the agent of the Trustees of said
Institution whereby it appears that full payment
has been made by the said Edmund King accor-
ding to the provisions of the Laws of the State
regulating the sale of the University lands for

the Lot numbered fourteen in the Town of Montevallo containing half an acre according to the plan of said town which said Lot has been purchased by the said Edmund King. Now know ye that the trustees of the University of Alabama in Consideration of the present and in conformity with the Ordinances of the Board of Trustees passed in pursuance of the acts of the General Assembly of the State of Alabama in such Cases made and provided have given and granted and by these Presents do give and grant unto the said Edmund King and to his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereto belonging unto the said Edmund King and to his assigns forever. In Testimony whereof I John Gayle President of the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama have caused these letters to be made patent and the Seal of the Corporation to be hereunto affixed. given under my hand at Tuscaloosa the twenty first day of December in the year of our Lord and thousand eight hundred and thirty one and of the Independence of the United States the fifty sixth.
