This Indenture made this 27 of February one thousand Eight hundred and forty four between Abel K Williams and Margaret Williams his wife of the County of Shelby in the State of Alabama of the one part and Kenneth L Morrison of the other part Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred ~~dollars~~ and seventy five dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has this day bargained and sold aliened Enfeoffed and Conveyed and by these Presents do bargain sell Enfeoff and Convey to the said Kenneth L Morrison all that Certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama to wit the South East half of the South East fourth of Section Seventeen Township twenty one Range One East Containing seventy nine acres and ninety six hundredths of an acre To have and to hold the above described land with the tenements and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Kenneth L Morrison and his heirs and assigns forever and the said party of the first part for their heirs Executors and administrators do warrant and well forever defend the title to the above and hereby granted premises unto the said Kenneth L Morrison his heirs & assigns forever and against the said Abel K Williams and Margaret Williams his wife and all and Every person or persons Claiming or holding under us the said Abel K Williams and Margaret Williams and also the lawful Claim title or demand of all and Every person or persons Whomsoever Claiming or holding by from or under the Government of the United States In testimony whereof the said Abel K Williams and Margaret Williams has hereunto set their hands and seals this day and year above Written { Abel K Williams seal
