 Eight hundred and fifty one between Richard
 S Griffin & Almira F Griffin his wife first and
 Kenneth L Morrison all of the above State & County
 of the second part Witnesseth that the said R S Griffin
 and A F Griffin for and in consideration of the
 sum of two hundred and fifty dollars the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged that this day given
 granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and
 confirmed and by these Presents doth give grant
 bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the
 said Kenneth L Morrison a Certain tract or parcel
 of land lying in said County and State and the
 Tuscaloosa land District known as the East
 half of the South West quarter of Section Number
 (17) in Township twenty one (21) of Range one East
 containing seventy nine 96/100 acres more or less
 To have and to hold the above described land
 and premises with all and singular the premises
 rights & privileges heretofore of in and to
 the same belonging or in anywise appertaining
 to the proper use benefit and behoof of the said
 R L Morrison his heirs and assigns forever—
