The State of Alabama } This indenture made this ^{18th}
Shelby County } day of July Eighteen hundred fifty one
between William C. Harris of the first part, and Wm H. Morgan
of the second part and W. Butler of the third part all of the
State and County above named. Witnesseth That whereas
the said William C. Harris is indebted to said W. Butler
in the sum of Sixty nine & 4/100 Dollars the same being Two
promissory notes of Thirty Four 4/100 dollars each, dated July
28th Eighteen hundred fifty one, and due one day after date,
with interest from the first of January last. By the said
Wm C. Harris have bargained sold, aliend, and conveyed
and by the presents doth bargain sell aliend and convey
unto the said W. H. Morgan for and in consideration of
the sum of five dollars of lawful money to said Wm
C. Harris by the the said W. H. Morgan in hand paid at
and before the Ensealing and delivering of these presents the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the following des-
cribed property To wit: - one Yoke four year old Steers
and one Two horse or Plantation Wagon, and one barrel
Horse about Eighty years old, I, William C. Harris
do for myself my heirs and assigns warrant and will ever
defend unto the said W. H. Morgan a good and lawful
right to the property herein described against all and Every
person whatsoever in trust, nevertheless should the said
Wm C. Harris pay or cause to be paid to the said W.
Butler the notes herein described on or before the first
day of November next then this obligation to be void
and of no Effect, but should the said Wm C. Harris
fail to pay the same on or before the first day of no-
vember next, in that case the said W. H. Morgan
may proceed to sell the property herein described at the
house where the said Wm C. Harris now lives first
giving fifteen days notice, and if there should re-
main a balance in the hands of the said W. H. Morgan
arising from the sale of the within described property
after paying the within described notes, then the said
W. H. Morgan shall pay the balance over to the said
