

The State of Alabama. To All Whom these Presents shall Come Greeting). Whereas Abram Butler of Shelly County Alabama has deposited with the Secretary of the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama a Certificate of the Executive Committee of the Trustees of said Institution whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Abram Butler according to the provisions of the Laws of the State Regulating the Sale of the University Land for the Lot No 38 in the Town of Montevallo Shelly County Containing One half acre more or less according to the official plat of the survey of said lands furnished by the Surveyor General Where said tract or lot has been purchased by the said Abram Butler.

Now Know Ye that the Trustees of the University of Alabama in Consideration of the premises and in Conformity with Ordinances of the Board of Trustees passed in pursuance of the acts of the General Assembly of the State of Alabama in such Case Made and provided have given and granted And by these Presents do give and grant unto the said Abram Butler and to his heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereto belonging unto the said Abram Butler and to his assigns forever In Testimony Whereof I Henry M. Collins President of the Board of Trustees of the University of Alabama have caused these Letters to be Made Patent and the seal of the Corporation to be hereunto affixed given under my hand at Tuscaloosa the twelfth day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and fifty and of the Independence of the United States the Seventy-fifth -
