The state of Alabama Shelly County Whereas I James M Fulley  
 Sheriff of Shelly County did under and by virtue of five orders  
 of Sale issued from the Circuit Court of Shelly County in favour  
 of Thomas Shawless of Edin King John West Wm D Penner  
 Joseph Roper & H Butter & Co respectively all against James L  
 Richardson & all issued 22 June 1850 & made returnable  
 to the Fall Term of Said Court on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of August  
 1850 in the Town of Montevallo within legal hours of Sale  
 after having given legal notice of Sale proceeded to sell  
 at Public Auction Cry to the highest bidder for Cash the  
 N E 1/4 of the S W 1/4 of Section four Township 24 Range  
 13 E and also a forty acre piece lying on the road from  
 Montevallo to Columbiana on which said Richardson lies  
 being the North East of the North West quarter of Section 4  
 Township 24 Range 13 E as the property of said Richardson  
 to satisfy said several Orders of Sale when Hiram Butler  
 who was the highest and best bidder became the purchaser  
 at the sum of one hundred and sixty two<sup>50</sup> / 100  
 dollars now therefore in consideration of the premises  
 I James M Fulley as Sheriff as aforesaid do hereby bargain  
 sell alien & convey unto the said Hiram Butler the  
 said lands with the privileges and appurtenances thereunto  
 belonging to have and to hold the aforesaid lands  
 privileges and appurtenances to him the said Hiram  
 Butler his heirs and assigns forever in the Sheriff  
 confirmed the said Richardson had and held the same  
 previous to these proceedings In witness of which I  
 as Sheriff aforesaid do hereunto set my name officially  
 & seal this 12<sup>th</sup> day of August AD 1850
