for forty dollars due the 25th Decr 1851 and to Jesse Cashat for
thirty seven dollars and which the said Lucinda George M.
Randall & John B. Wilson as my securities said note due
the 25th Dec 1851. and one note to William S. Prentice on
which the said Lucinda & George M. Randall as securities
for thirty dollars due the 25th Decr 1851 in order to hold said
securities harmless as well for the sum of one dollar to me in
hand paid by them the receipt of which is fully acknowledge.
I do hereby give grant bargain sell and convey and by these
presents do give grant bargain sell & convey to the said
Lucinda my wife George M. Randall & John B. Wilson
my entire interest in my growing crop of the present year which
is left after the payment of one hundred dollars heretofore
secured to my wife Lucinda by a certain obligation which
is recorded in the office of the Probate Judge in the County
afore said in record book J. on pages 421 & 22. The above in-
terest to have and to hold the same until they are or about to
be made to suffer from said securityship. Then the said Lucinda
my wife George M. Randall & John B. Wilson or their
legal representatives may seize and sell said interest for cash
to the highest bidder at publick sale after advertising for twenty
days at two or more publick places in said County, the sale on
the premises, and out of said sale first pay and satisfy the afore
mentioned notes, and the balance if any pay over to me. But
if the said L. Cook should pay or cause to be paid. The above
notes at the time or before their falling due then this obligation
to be void, else to remain in full force This the 20th August AD 1851
