That for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledge the said William W. King hath bargained & sold, & by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the said Ware, & Gardner & Woodruff, the south east quarter of the North West quarter of section eight in Township Twenty four of Range twelve East in the Gualuosa land district containing Forty & $\frac{3}{100}$ acres;

To have and to hold the same together with all the rights, privileges, immunities & appertinances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the heirs & assigns forever & their title to the same will forever warrant and defend against all persons whatsoever.
