thirty four Township no Twenty one of Range one East containing
seventy Two acres and half more or less nevertheless the line layed
between Thomas Horton and said Mical J. Horton Junr. is to be the
boundary line I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and ad
ministrators and assigns forever to warrant and Defend
the right and title of the above named Tract or parcel
of Land against me ourselves our administrators or Executors
or assigns or against any other person or persons lawfully
claiming the same or any part thereof their or theirs whereunto
we have set our names and affixed our seals the day and date
