sold and by these presents does give grant bargain and sell
to said creditor one hundred and fifty bushels of corn, now
gathered & cribed at the place where said McCombes resides to
have and hold the same upon trust till default be made
in the payment of said debt to said Roper the said Rush-
ing may procure at public or private sale the corn aforesaid
or a sufficient thereof and pay said debt to said Roper and
the overplus if any to said McCombes but should said debt
be fully paid to said Roper by said McCombes then this
deed to be null and void else to remain in full force =
