Court of Probate for Bibb County made May the 26 day 1851
by which Decree I as Executor aforesaid and curator on the petition
of Richmond Merrill and Wiley Merrill a firmness of Benjamin
Merrill to make and execute title to said Petitioners Per-
suant to the title bond of said Executor made in his lifetime
to make title to the following land in said County viz
the E 1/2 of Fractional Section 22 Township 22 Range one East
Containing two hundred & four acres more or less also the
S. W. 1/4 of the S. W. 1/4 of section fifteen all in the same Town-
ship and Range, I as Executor pursuant to said order & decree the
Consideration money for said land being fully paid
hand given granted bargined and sold & and by these presents
do give grant bargain and sell to said Richmond and Wiley
Merrill the land aforesaid as fully and completely in all
things as under and by virtue of the authority aforesaid
