Azariah Merrell, the following land lying and being in
said County viz the S.W. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 Section 22
T. 22 R. 1 E. and the S.W. 1/4 fractional fourth of S.E. 1/4
Section 22 T. 22 R. 1 E. Containing sixty three
acres more or less To have and to hold the aforegranted
premises to the said Azariah Merrell his heirs and as-
signs to their use and behoof forever And we do covenant with
the said A. Merrell & his heirs and assigns that we are
lawfully seized in fee of the aforegranted premises, that they
are free of all incumbrances that we a good right to sell and
convey the said land to him and his heirs and assigns and
that we will warrant and defend the said premises to the said
A. Merrell & his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful
claims and demands of all persons In Witness whereof we
the said Merrell & Merrell have hereunto set our hands
and seals this 18 day of October in year of our Lord 1857.
