This Indenture made and entered into this the fourth day of October Eighteen Hundred and fifty one between William Ozley of the County of Shelby and State of Alabama of the one part and Lawrence M. Jones and James D. Allen Trustees for the Baptist Denomination and their successors in office of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said William Ozley for and in consideration of the Love and affection he has and bears the Baptist denomination and the sum of one Dollar to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. the this day bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents doth bargain sell and convey unto the said L. M. Jones & J. D. Allen Trustees for the Baptist Denomination and their successors in offices one acre of Land Lying on the west or south west of the road running by said Ozleys and north west of said Wm Ozleys Dwelling house and north west of a certain Pond near said Ozleys Dwelling said acre of land is a part of the West half of the North East quarter of section Twenty Township Twenty one range Two west Tuscaloosa Land District together with all and singular the appertinances thereto belonging for the purpose to build thereon a church house for the use of the Baptist Denomination and I said William Ozley doth warrant and will ever defend the right and title to the above described and hereby conveyed said premises unto the said L. M. Jones & J. D. Allen Trustees as aforesaid and also against the claims of myself my heirs Executors and administrators and all other persons claiming by or from under the General government of the United States of America to the said L. M. Jones & J. D. Allen Trustees of the said Baptist Denomination to build a church house on and for no other purpose Intestimony whereof I the said William Ozley have hereunto set
