 benefit all and singular one dark Bay horse to have
 and to hold for his own use and benefit from all and every
 person like unto those I Seal Infant son of D. J. Seal
 for the love and good will I have for him I give and
 bequeath to him one white cow and yearling to have and
 to hold for his own use and benefit from all and every
 person what soever In Testimony Whereof I have here-
 unto set my hand and seal this the 8th of November
 1857 and of the American Independence the seventy
 sixth Rachel Seal
