have bargained & sold & do now by these presents bargain sell
& convey unto said Thompson the following designated
Tract of land Situated in said County & Tuscaloosa Land
district to wit the East half of the South East fractional
Section 36 Township 21 of Range one East fifty seven 4/10
acres more or less to have and to hold unto said Thompson
his heirs & assigns forever In trust however & these presents
are upon these conditions that if said Williams shall make
default in the payment of said notes as the same may be
come due that said Thompson his executor administrator
or assignee may sell said tract of land at the Court house
door of said County of Shelby after giving ten days thereof to
the highest bidder for cash & out of the proceeds shall pay &
satisfy whatever sum or sums of money & expenses attending
the same that may be due & unpaid, if sufficient, the
excess if any paid to said Williams his executor, &c.
but if said notes are punctually paid, as the same
become due, then this obligation to be void. If a
