 Shelby County 3 day of January 1852 between
 Sunday Hail, of the 1st part and Washington R. Rus-
 hingon of the 2^d part witnesseth that the party of the
 Hail 1st part & Squire L. Hail are indebted to said party of
 To Rushing the 2^d part by note of this date to be due 1 Janry 1853.
 the sum of fifty four dollars. which said party
 of the first part is anxious & desirous to secure therefore
 for and in consideration of the promises as well the
 sum of one dollar to him in hand paid the receipt of
 which is hereby acknowledged, the party of the 1st part
 has given granted bargained and sold and by these presents
 to does give grant bargain & sell to said party of the 2^d
 part a certain dark brown horse mule to have and to
 hold forever upon trust until default be made in the
 payment of said sum of fifty four dollars whole or
 in part then said Rushing his heirs Representatives

or assigns may seize & take said mule into possession
& the same sell to the highest bidder for cash. By giving
fifteen days notice of the time and place of said sale & out
of the proceeds of said sale pay said debt & the cost of this
Deed and the balance pay over to said Hale but should
the same be fully paid then this Deed is void signed
sealed & delivered in presence

of me this 15th day of Jan'y 1852.
