attorney in fact for me and in my name to settle Gen-
erally my unfinished business to collect any accounts
due me & receipt for the same if necessary to sell and convey
any personal or real property and make good the title
therunto and in a word to do execute and perform every
thing necessary about the settlement of any unfinished busi-
ness ratifying & confirming whatsoever my said attorney
shall do as fully in all things as if I were present personally
at the doing thereof Witness my hand and seal this 26th day
