 N. East containing 40 acres more or less. Together with all & singular
 the right & Privileges in any wise appertaining or belonging to
 said Land & premises & we the said Nathan P. Primm &
 Susanna Primm his wife against ourselves our heirs &
 and Every other person or persons well Warrant & Defend
 the Right & Title of said & premises unto the only proper use
 and Benefit & behoof of the said Zachariah Wall his heirs &
 assigns & Co. in fee simple for Ever in Testimony where of we
 here unto set our hands & seals this the 6th December 1851
 signed sealed & delivered in the presents Nathan Primm (real)
 of E. N. Burchful Susanna ^{her} Primm (real)
 mark

The State of Alabama, Before me Elijah Burchful a Justice
 Shelby County } of the Peace in & for said County

 that she signed the foregoing Instrument Without fear
