

This Indenture made this 8th day of March 1859
 between W W Atkinson the debtor of the first part
 Isaac Walker the trustee of the second part and Edm Ring
 the creditor of the third part Witnesseth that whereas the
 said W W Atkinson is justly indebted to the said Ring in
 the sum of two hundred & twenty five dollars by note of
 hand dated the 24th day of February A.D. 1858 and due
 Twelve months after date which debt he is desirous and
 Willing to secure Now this Indenture Witnesseth for and in
 consideration premises and also for the further consid-
 eration of one dollar to the said Ring paid by the said
 Isaac Walker before the signing hereof the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged by the said W W Atkinson both and doth
 by these presents give grant sell & confirm unto the said
 Isaac Walker his heirs and assigns forever A certain tract
 of Land lying and being in Shelby County Alabama
 designated at the C/P of the NW 1/4 of Section 35 Township 20
 of Range three West also the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of the same
 Section together with all & singular the appurtenances thereto
 belonging or in wise appertaining To have and to hold the
 said hereby granted tract of Land to the said Isaac Walker
 his heirs executors & administrators and assigns to his & their
 only proper use & behoof forever hereby warranting and defen-
 ding the same against the claims of all persons whatso-
 ever upon trust nevertheless that the said Isaac Walker
 his heirs we shall permit the said Atkinson to receive
 in quiet possession of said tract of Land until default is
 made in the payment of said debt and then upon this further
 trust that by the said Trustee shall and will as soon as
 such default happens & the said Ring require sell the said
 tract of Land & premises to the highest bidder for cash at
 public auction at Mobile Alabama upon giving thirty days
 notice by advertisement at three public places in Shelby

County and after paying the said Edm^d Ring the
said sum of two hundred and twenty five dollars
and interest if any then shall be also the expenses & charges
of said sale shall pay to the said Atkinson
the balance if any but if the whole of the said
debt and interest shall be fully paid off when due then
this Indenture to be null & void else to remain in full
