

The State of Alabama, This Indenture made and
 Shelby County Entered into this 10th day of
 March A.D. 1852. Between James R. Golly of the first
 part and David N. McLanahan and Joseph Roper of
 the second part all of the State and County aforesaid
 Witnesseth that whereas the party of the first part is justly
 indebted to the parties of the second part the sum of
 Three hundred ninety six $75/100$ Dollars due the first day
 of March 1852 four promissory notes as follows. two for
 thirty $75/100$ Dollars Each. Whereof Golly Endorser paya-
 ble to Joseph Roper or bearer also one for one hundred
 sixty seven $75/100$ Dollars made payable to D. N. Mc-
 lanahan or bearer; Which said debts said Golly is anxious
 and desirous to secure therefore for and in consideration of
 the premises as well the sum of one dollar to him in
 hand paid by the said Roper & McLanahan the receipt, wher-
 of is hereby acknowledged said J. R. Golly has given, grant-
 ed, bargained and sold and by these presents does give, grant
 bargain and sell unto said Roper and McLanahan the
 following lands lying and being in said County and Re-
 nown as the N.W. $1/4$ of the North West quarter of section
 thirty four in Township Twenty one Range one West contain-
 ing forty acres and sixty seven $1/2$ hundredths also the South
 West Quarter of the South East Quarter of section no. 07
 in Township 21 of Range 1 West containing forty
 acres and Eighty $1/2$ hundredths also the North East
 half of the North East Quarter of section thirty four
 Township 21 of Range one west containing Eighty
 acres more or less to have and to hold said lands and
 premises to said Roper & McLanahan & their heirs
 forever upon trust nevertheless till default be made
 in the payment of said Three hundred ninety six $75/100$
 Dollars in whole or in part upon which said default
 said Roper & McLanahan their Representatives or assigns
 may sell and convey the title to said lands to the
 highest bidder for cash first having given twenty
 days notice of the time and place of said sale by
 advertisement in at least three public places in said
 county and sell the same to the highest Bidder for
 cash and out of said sale pay the Expenses here of
 and said debt or the balance if any pay over to said
 J. R. Golly but should the whole of the same be paid
