five dollars by note of this date to be due the 1<sup>st</sup> day  
of December next which said debt the said Mitchel is  
desirous & willing to secure therefore for and in considera-  
tion of the premises as well the further sum of one dollar  
to him in hand paid by said Proper the receipt of which is  
hereby acknowledged said Mitchel has given granted bar-  
gained and sold and by these presents does give grant bar-  
gain & sell to said Proper a certain black mare mule the  
same now in the possession of said Mitchel and the crop  
of corn cotton and small grain to be raised by said  
Mitchel the present year upon trust said Mitchel is to retain  
in said ~~possession~~<sup>possession</sup> property till default be made in the pay-  
ment of said debt then said Proper his heirs or assigns may  
seize and take said property into possession and sell the same  
to the highest bidder for cash after giving fifteen days notice  
of the time and place of said sale by advertisement and  
out of said sale pay said debt and the cost hereof but should  
said debt be fully paid then this deed to be void
