

This Indenture made and entered into this 12th day of September
 AD 1851 between Merie J. Heortan and Noreira Heortan his
 wife in their own right and the said Merie J. Heortan attorney
 in fact for Logan D. Doak and Secunda his wife Daniel D.
 Heortan and Mary Eliza his wife Westly Arnett James Arnett
 and Nancy Caroline Arnett of the first part and Heortan
 Ann young wife of William young of the second part
 of the county of Shelby and state of Alabama Witnesseth
 that the said Noreira Heortan Secunda Doak Mary
 Eliza Heortan Westly Arnett James Arnett Nancy Caroline
 Arnett and Heortan Ann young are the children of Thomas
 Arnett dec'd late of said County and except the bequest to
 the Widow of the said Thomas Arnett dec'd the sole legatee
 in the last will and Testament of the said Thomas Arnett
 dec'd and that the said Merie J. Heortan is the Executor

of the said last will and Testament of the said Thomas Arnett decd. that the legacy to each of said children under said will is six hundred and Eighty five dollars. And the said Harriet Ann Young agreed to and hereby accepts in full discharge of her said legacy under said will & Testament the following described lands a part of the real Estate of which the said Thomas Arnett Decd. did send and proposed to wit the west half of the north west quarter of section five in Township twenty four Range Thirteen East also North west quarter of south west quarter of section 8. T4. R 13. E. Now for and in consideration of the above promises we the parties of the first part hereby sell convey and forever quit claim to the said Harriet Ann Young to her sole and separate use all right title claims and interest in as heirs at law and legates under the will of said Thomas Arnett decd. have in & to said above described lands to have and to hold with all & singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to her and to the heirs of her body forever and we hereby bind ourselves each of ourselves our and each of our heirs forever to warrant and defend to the said Harriet Ann Young and to her heirs all the right title claims and interest that hath accrued to or rests in or any of us in and to said land as heirs at law or legates under the will of the said Thomas Arnett decd. against us or any of us our or either of our heirs and against every other person claiming under arrangement or by us or either of us our or either of our heirs given under our hands and seals this day and year above written
