1851 between Edward Ring of the one part and Palsey
Bullock of the other part; All of the said County & State
Witnesseth that, that fore and in consideration of the
sum of Twelve hundred dollars to me in hand paid

Natsey Bullock. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 ed have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain
 sell and convey unto the said Natsey Bullock the following
 described tract of land described as follows— section number
 5 of Township twenty one of Range two East on the West
 side of Coosa River in said Shelby County & Decatur Land
 District containing about Eighty five acres in the same
 more or less also the undivided two fifths in the North
 West Fraction of section no 5 in the same Township and
 Range on the East side of the Coosa River & Decatur Land
 District together with all & singular the Privileges and
 advantages to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining
 to have & to hold unto her the said Natsey Bullock her heirs
 & assigns forever and I the said Edm^d Ring for myself
 heirs Executors & administrators unto her the said Natsey
 Bullock her heirs & assigns do warrant & forever defend the
 Title of said Tract of land against the claims of all persons
 whomsoever. In Witness whereof I hereunto set my name
 & annex my seal in common form on the day & year a-
 -bove written
