 lect receive & receipt for any and all such property real personal or im-
 mixed as shall have descended to or been given to the said words
 of the said William S. Morgan and the said Samuel W.
 Morgan & Ruben R. Morgan by our grandfather Ruben M.
 orris & the shall have descended to us from the Estate of the
 said Ruben Morris due as the grand children and heirs
 at law of the Estate of our said grandfather who hath lately
 departed this life in the State of Alabama & County of Shelby
 & to settle up with the legal representatives of the said Ruben
 Morris deceased for any and all such interest as in may have
 in said Estate And for the purpose aforesaid we do hereby
 grant unto our said attorney full power and authority to
 Execute and deliver all real and personal instruments and papers whether
 under seal or otherwise to institute and prosecute to final judgmen-
 ent and Execution all process in Law or in Equity to defend
 any and all suits against us the constitution to submit any
 all matters in dispute to arbitration or the same to settle
