 1st part and Joseph Proper of the 2nd part Witnesseth that
 the party of the first is indebted to the party of the
 2nd part the sum of one hundred and twenty five
 dollars by promissory note to be due 25th December next
 which said debt said O'Hara is anxious and desirous
 to secure therefore for and in consideration of the
 premises as well the sum of five dollars to him paid
 in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowl-
 edged the said O'Hara has given granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents does give grant
 bargain and sell to said Proper & to his heirs forever a new
 family carriage and the same the same manufactured
 by A. V. A. G. Merrill to have and hold the same forever
 upon Trust however said O'Hara is to retain the pos-
 session of said carriage & harness until default be made
 in the payment of said debt then said Proper or his Rep-
 resentatives or assigns may seize & sell said carriage for
 cash 15th giving 30 days notice of the time & place
 of said sale by advertisement and out of said sale
 pay said debt but should then same be fully paid
 by said O'Hara this deed to be void & of force
 Witness our hands and seals.
