

The Indenture made and Contract unto this 5th day of April no 1852 between Thomas H. Brush - Administrator of the Estate of Jesse Burton dec'd of the first and Blessing arm Nabors of the second part with covenants that on the 31st day of January 1851 the said Thomas H. Brush, administrator as aforesaid under and by virtue of and order of the Probate court of the County of Shelby in the State of Alabama sold to the highest bidder the following described land a part of the real estate of his intestate to wit the East half of the north ^{east} fourth of section three of Township Twenty one of Range three west in the Tuscaloosa land district that the said Blessing arm Nabors became the purchaser for the sum of Two hundred dollars payable on Two and Three years thereafter by giving notes with approved security that the said

Blossingame Nabors has fully complied with the terms of said sale that the said seal has been accepted by said administrator to said Probate court and by said Probate court fully approved that said Administrator has been directed by order of said court to make a title to above described land according to said purchase and sale therefor and in consideration of the premises the said Thomas H. Brasher administrator as afore said hereby sells conveys and confirms unto the said Blossingame Nabors all right title claim and interest of which the said Jesse Benton died seized and possessed in and to said before described land and to have and hold to the said Blossingame Nabors his heirs and assigns forever together with the appurtenances thereto belonging given under my hand and seal this 5 day of April A.D. 1854.
