Given and conveyed and by these presents doth bargain sell. alien and convey unto the said Charles S. Pringle for and in consideration of the sum of five Dollars of lawful money by the said Charles S. Pringle to the Lewis Burdett in hand paid at and before the signing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the following ^{described} property to wit one negro Boy named Mat age about thirty years. I the said Lewis Burdett do for myself my heirs and assigns warrant and will ever defend unto the said Charles S. Pringle a good lawful right to the property herein described against all

and every person who takes in trust nevertheless.
should the said Lewis Burdun pay or cause to be
paid to the said He Butler the note herein described.
on or before the twenty fifth day of December next that
this obligation to be paid and of no effect but should
the said Lewis Burdun fail to pay the sum aforesaid.
before the 5. day of December next in that case the said
Charles S. Pringley may proceed to sell the property herein de-
scribed at the Town of Manassas for giving thirty days
notice and then the said Charles S. Pringley shall apply
the proceeds to the payment of the note herein described
and if there should remain a balance in the hands of
the said Charles S. Pringley arising from the sale of
the within described property after paying the within
described note then the said Charles S. Pringley shall pay
the balance over to the said Lewis Burdun after
paying the expenses of carrying this trust in to effect
given under my hand and seal this 16. day
