

The State of Alabama. This Indenture made this twenty

thirty seventh day of July Eighteen hundred fifty two between William Moore of the first part J. P. Nelson of the second part and Jas D. Nelly of the third part all of the State and County of said Montgomery that Whereas the said William Moore is indebted to the said Jas D. Nelly in the sum of Forty six & 70/100 Dollars the same being a promissory note dated July 31 1852 due the 1st August next with interest from date — If the said ~~Wm~~ Moore have bargained sold aliened conveyed and by these presents doth bargain sell alien and convey unto the said J. P. Nelson for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars of lawful money by the said J. P. Nelson to the said ~~Wm~~ Moore paid out and before the Executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the following described property to wit — one yoke of Steers one Red the other Red side & white buck about six years old last Spring also one Plantation to w^{ch} J. D. ~~Wm~~ Moore do for myself my heirs and assigns warrant & will ever defend unto the said J. P. Nelson a good and lawful right to the property herein described against all and every person whatsoever in trust notwithstanding should the said William Moore pay or cause to be paid to the said Jas D. Nelly the moneys herein described as or before the 1st day of August next then this obligation to be paid and if my official fail should the said ~~Wm~~ Moore fail to pay the same as or before the first day of August next in that case the said J. P. Nelson may proceed to sell the property herein described at the place where the said ~~Wm~~ Moore now lives first among fifteen day notice and if there should remain a balance in the hands of the said J. P. Nelson arising from the sale of the within described property after paying the within described sum unto them the said J. P. Nelson shall pay the balance over to the said William Moore after paying the expenses of carrying on this trust into effect Given under my hand and seal this 31st day of July 1852
