 Shelby County 3 into this 11. day of April 1852
 between David Cullen, David N. McClanahan & William
 N. Hartman commissioners appointed by the Orphans Court
 of Shelby County to sell the real Estate of Henry B. Robinson
 on Behalf of the one part and Daniel Guardian of the other
 part all of the county & State aforesaid Witnesseth that where
 as said Henry B. died Intestate and upon application of Gasper
 Robinson the administrators of said H. B. to the said
 Orphans Court an order and decree was made directing
 a sale of the real Estate of said H. B. upon certain
 conditions and whereas the undersigned were appointed:

For the sum of Eleven hundred dollars where the same was worked off to him for the same and where as we have reported said sale to the exors. court of said county who has ordered and directed is to make due and carry the title to said Daniel Gardner, Therefore for and in consideration of said sum of Eleven hundred dollars the sum bid as aforesaid as well secured by said Gardner according to the terms of said sale we have given granted bargained and sold and by these Presents do give grant bargain and sell to said Daniel Gardner and to his heirs, assigns, the land aforesaid to have and to hold the same for ever as fully and completely in all things as we under the authority of aforesaid case do in testimony of which.
