 is hereby acknowledged do give Grant bargain, sell, Assign
 convey, and confirm, unto the said Paul Lulane
 his heirs, and assigns the following described parcels of
 land with the Privileges, and appurtenances thereto
 belonging situated in in the county of Shelby State
 of Alabama, to wit the South East Quarter of the
 North West Quarter of section No 7 Township 20 Range
 three East containing forty acres. The north west
 Quarter of the South East Quarter of section Township
 Range as aforesaid containing forty acres. The North
 East quarter of the North East Quarter of section No
 (18) Township Twenty (20) Range (3) East containing
 forty acres. The North East Quarter of the North West
 Quarter and the North East Quarter of the South
 West Quarter of section No (7) same Township and
 Range as above stated containing Eighty Acres (80)
 in all Two hundred Acres also Three hundred and fifty
 acres known as the North East Quarter of section No
 (18) same Township (20) Range No 2 East
 and the East half of the South East Quarter, and thirty
 acres of the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter
 both in section No (12) same Township and
 Range as above stated also the West half of the South
 West 1/4 section of No (7) Township (20) Range (3)
