 consideration of one hundred Dollars to have
 paid in hand the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged have bargained sold and conveyed and
 by these presents do bargain sell and convey unto
 him the said Jas D. Coacy beginning at the south
 East corner of the North East Quarter of section
 Nine Township Twenty one Range Three West Thence west
 Eighty Rod. Thence North sixty Rod. Thence East Eighty
 Rod. Thence South to the beginning corner containing
 thirty acres lying and being in the county and State
 aforesaid together with all and singular the Right and
 privileges and improvements appertaining to the
 same being bearing or otherwise appertaining to the
 said Jas. D. Coacy his heirs Executors administrators
 and assigns from said David Meridith & Elizabeth
 Meridith their heirs Executors administrators & assigns.
