 Shelby County 3 and Entered into this 17th
 day of September 1852 between Minor H. Wilder and
 Vincent, J. Wilder the debtors M. B. Smith the Executor
 and C. S. Lowrey and Co, the creditors Whereof it
 that the said Minor H. & Vincent J. Wilder is fully
 indebted to the said C. S. Lowrey & Co. in the sum
 of one hundred and fifty three 89,100 of Dollars now
 due as by four notes one for forty two dollars and
 for forty three dollars and for forty five dollars and
 one for twenty three 89,100 dollars which will more
 fully appear by said notes bearing date with these
 presents which said sum of one hundred and fifty
 three 89,100 of Dollars the said Minor H. & Vincent J.

Wilder being willing and desirous to secure the
bargain sold and conveyed and by these presents
doth bargain sell and convey unto the said
B Smith Trustee as aforesaid his heirs and assigns
a certain block pack by the name of Block Hawk to have
and to hold the said pack Block Hawk with all the
rite title same and interest of same unto said pack
nevertheless it is understood that this deed of trust
is made upon the express condition that if the said
Wilder shall will and truly pay or cause to be paid to the
said E B Sawley & Co the said sum of one hundred and fifty
three 89/100 of dollars by the said sum 1859 with interest from
date of before said date of said deed to be void and
of no effect but if the said Wilder shall make default in the
payment of the said sum of money in said note
specified or any part thereof then the said E B Sawley & Co may
as soon as they think proper after which default of said payment
require the said B Smith Trustee as aforesaid to sell the
said pack to the highest bidder for ready money before
the county house door in Shelby county after giving
ten days notice of the time and place of said sale by
advertisement in three or more public places in
said county and out of the proceeds arising from
said sale pay and satisfy the said amount in said
note specified with any interest that may arise with
any other charges arising from the same and
if any of the proceeds of said sale remain the same
shall be paid over to the said Minor Governor and
S Wilder in writing whereof we have hereunto set
our names and affixed our seals the day and date
