

This Indenture made and Entered into this
 the day of September A.D. 1852 between
 John Baker administrator of the Estate of Hugh
 McLeann and Ashley W. High Sheriff of
 the County of Shelby State of Alabama seized and possessed of the follow-
 ing described lands that the said John Baker
 was by the then Orphans Court appointed
 administrator of the Estate of said Hugh
 McLeann that as such administrator the
 said John Baker filed his petition in said
 court praying for an order to sell said
 real estate of his intestate for the purpose of equal
 distribution among the heirs of said intestate
 that all due and legal notice were given
 that pursuant to the prayer of said petition
 an order was granted directing the said
 administrator to sell said real estate that under
 and by virtue of said Order of said court the above
 named John Baker did on the 20th day of Septem-
 ber 1852 sell to the highest bidder the said real
 estate after having given due and legal notice
 of said sale according to such laws
 that at said sale the above named

Ashley W Spaight became the purchaser of the lands herein after described for the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars. to wit the west half of the south west fourth of section six of Township twenty two of Range one west adjoining the Shelby Springs. a part of the real estate of said intestate that the said Ashley W Spaight has fully complied with the terms of said deed by executing to the said administrator his promissory note with good and approved security for said purchase money that the said deed has been by the said administrator ^{approved} for the said Probate court for said county and by said court fully approved and ordered that said court by formal decree therein directed the said administrator to execute letters to the said purchaser for said lands. Now for and in consideration of the premises I John Baker administrator as of said do hereby alien sell and convey to the said Ashley W Spaight his heirs and assigns forever all the right title claim and interest which the said Hugh McLean had at his death in and to the said land together with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto me my heirs and seal this the 20th day and year first above written the word administrator of the Estate of Hugh McLean between the second and third terms in herein before signed.
