

The State of Alabama, This Deed of Trust made and Entered
Shelby County 3 unto this 4 day of October 1852
between to-wit: Healey the debtor of the 1st part Joseph
Proper and John Mc. McClunahan the creditors of the second
part and Samuel Mc. Johnson the Trustee of the 3rd part
Witnesseth that the said party of the 1st part is indebted
to the said Proper the sum of Two hundred and
thirty nine & 100 dollars the amount of a judgment
in the Circuit Court of said County in favor of
said Proper and against said Healey & Co. & Williams
rendered on the 8 day of September 1852 & Interest there
on from the time of its rendition making
now Two hundred and thirty dollars and thirty
said Healey is indebted to the said McClunahan
the amount of forty five & 100 dollars due by prom
issory note of this date & due one day after date whic
he said that said Healey is anxious and desiring
to secure therefore for and in consideration of the
premises as well the sum of one dollar to him in
hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said
Healey has given granted bargained and sold and by these
Presently does give grant bargain and sell to said Johnson
a negro Girl Slave named Julia of dark complexion
to have and to hold the same forever unto trust nevertheless
said Healey is to retain the possession of said negro
Slave for one month and should the said debt be
fully paid said Johnson as Trustee of the said mortgage
said Slave and take here into his possession and give fifteen
days notice by advertisement of the time and place &
sell the same in Columbia to the highest bidder
for cash and out of said sale pay and satisfy said debt
and the costs of this Trust and the balance if any
pay to said Healey but should said debt be fully paid
without a sale of said Slave then this Deed is to be void
Else remain in full force Witness our hands & seals
