 convey unto him the said Jas P. D. Lacey a certain lot  
 or parcel of land lying and being in the county  
 and state aforesaid, subject to Entry at Los Cabos and  
 offer being a part of Section Eight Township Twenty Range  
 three East being the south half of North East Qu-  
 arters of Section Eight Township Twenty Range  
 three West also the South East Quarters of said Section  
 containing two hundred and forty acres & 21/100  
 of an acre lying and being in the county aforesaid  
 together with all and singular the rights and privileges  
 appertaining to the said Jas P. D. Lacey his heirs  
 administrators and assigns from the said David  
 Meredith and Elizabeth his wife their heirs adminis-  
 trators and assigns. well warrant and forever  
 defend in fee simple in Witness whereof we  
 the said David Meredith and Elizabeth his wife  
 have hereunto set our names and annexed our  
 seals and delivered in the presence of  
 February 24. 1843.
