

This Indenture made and Entered into this the nineteenth  
 day of November in the year 1852 between Wm. H. Young debtor  
 of the first part - Rodolph E. George creditor party of the second  
 part and Jacobus Leary trustee party of the third part  
 Witnesseth that the said William H. Young party of the first  
 is justly indebted to the said Rodolph E. George party of the  
 second part in the sum of thirteen dollars & fifty cents which  
 the said R. E. George paid for the said Wm. H. Young  
 on a judgment pending against him the said  
 Young in a Magistrate's Court for said county  
 and in favor of John Amos. Now the said  
 Young being willing and desirous to secure to the  
 said R. E. George the payment of said sum of thirteen  
 dollars & fifty cents as by the present bargain sell  
 and convey unto the said John Leary trustee as  
 aforesaid one dark sorrel horse to have and to hold  
 in Trust nevertheless on the following Express condition  
 viz that the said Young is to retain the possession of said  
 horse until the first day of January 1853 by which  
 time if the said Young shall pay off said debt  
 the above stated debt then this conveyance is to be void

and of no Effect but if said William H. Young  
shall fail to satisfy said debt by the said first day of any  
month then the said trustee as aforesaid shall take the said  
horse into his possession and after giving ten days notice by  
advertising in three public places in said county to sell  
public sale said horse for cash to the highest bidder and give  
the proceeds of said sale to pay off and satisfy said debt  
in trust thereon together with the other expenses of this trust  
and the residue if any shall pay over to the said Wm H. Young
