 Shelby county 3 into this the fourteenth day of Oct
 one thousand Eight hundred and fifty Two between James
 McJohnston and his wife Rebecca Johnston of the first part
 and James Jones of the second part all of the county and
 State of aforesaid Mississippi that the said party of the first part
 hath this day bargained and sold and do by these presents
 bargain sell convey and deliver unto James Jones his heirs and
 assigns a certain tract or parcel of
 land lying and being in the county of Shelby & State of
 Alabama and known as follows to wit the south
 West quarter of the south East quarter of section thirty four
 north twenty of Range Two west containing 40 acres 4/100
 For the consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty
 dollars in hand paid by the said James Jones the receipt
 whereof is here by acknowledged and the said party

of the first part part each for themselves their heirs Executors admin-
istrators & assigns. Warrant and define all the right title and interest
of said land unto the said party of the second part his heirs &c
together with all that in any wise appertaining unto said land
to have and to hold for his own use and benefit.
