 have & hold the same forever & so covenant to and with
 said Barrell & Crawford that I am lawfully seized of the
 lot of land aforesaid that I have a good right to sell the same
 & that I will forever Warrant & defend the titles to the same
 to said 2. party & to which I bind myself my heirs & representa-
 tives forever In Witness of which Witness my hand & Seal
