of the sum of five dollars of lawful money by
the said Charles S. Rawley to the said James
H. Broadhead in hand paid at and before the
making and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged the following
described property to wit One Bright sorrel
mare an eye and blaze face - & the said James H.
Broadhead do for myself my heirs and assigns warrant
and well enure defend unto the said Charles S.
Rawley a good and lawful right to the
property herein described against all any person
whatsoever in trust now or hereafter the said James
H. Broadhead pay or cause to be paid the said He Butley
the note herein described on or before the first day of
March next then this obligation to be void and of no
Effect but should the said James H. Broadhead fail
to pay the same on or before the first day of March
next in that case the said Charles S. Rawley may proceed
to sell the property herein described at the town of Man-
tenello first giving fifteen days notice and then the
said Charles S. Rawley shall apply the proceeds to the
payment of the note herein described and if there
shall remain a balance in the hands of the
said Charles S. Rawley arising from the sale of
the within described property after paying the note
in described note then the said Charles S. Rawley
shall pay the balance owing to the said James H.
