

The State of Alabama This deed of Trust made
 Hubby County 3 and Entered into this
 13th day of January AD 1853 between Charles Bragg
 the debtor of the 1st part David V. McClanahan
 the Trustee of the 2nd part and John F. Crummett
 creditor of the third part all of the county and State
 of said Alabama that the party of the 1st part has
 justly indebted to the party of the 3^d part the sum
 of Two hundred and forty seven 74/100 dollars by
 promissory note bearing even date herewith to be
 due the 1st day of January 1854 Which said debt
 said party of the first part is anxious and desirous
 to secure therefore for and in consideration of the
 premises as well the sum of five dollars to him in
 hand paid by said David V. McClanahan to said
 Charles Bragg the Receipt Whereof is here by ack-
 nowledged that said Charles Bragg has given grant
 sold bargained and sold to said David V. McClanahan
 and by this present deed give grant bargain and
 sell to said McClanahan a negro woman slave
 of dark complexion and age about thirty
 years of age more or less to him and his heirs
 the sum of money above trust money the interest
 default be made in the payment of the
 debt aforesaid and if whereby Expressly agreed &
 understood that said Bragg is to retain the
 possession of said Negro Woman until default
 be made in the payment of said debt in
 whole or in part then upon such default
 McClanahan or his Representatives may sell &
 sell said Slave to the highest bidder for cash first
 fixing the time and place of said sale and
 giving at least twenty days notice by advertisement
 in at least three public places in said county
 and out of the proceeds of said sale pay &
 satisfy said debt but should the said debt be fully
 paid Without a sale of said Slave then this deed
 to be void and no Effect Withaps and heras &
 seals.
