 I am also indebted to Robert R. Rushing in the
 further sum of Twenty two \$6/100 Dollars also by note
 payable to him of this date due first of January next with
 interest from date on both of which H. C. Horton
 & Isaac W. Edwards are securing the payments of
 both of which I am desirous to secure, have
 therefore in consideration of the promises as
 well as of an dollar to me in hand paid by
 said Rushing & Sawyer the receipt of which is
 here acknowledged I have bargained & sold & do now
 by these presents bargain & sell unto the said
 Rushing & Sawyer the following named negroes to wit
 a negro man named Bob about twenty one years old
 & a negro woman named Sylvia about forty
 five or six years old to have and to hold the
 same to them their Executors and administrators
 or assigns forever. In test hereunto and this

Conveyance is upon this Condition that I am to retain possession of said negroes and if said notes with interest is fully paid off & discharged an. or. before their maturity together with the expenses of this conveyance then the same to be void & of no effect but should default be made in the payment thereof in whole or in part said Rushing & Sawyer or either of them the Executor or Administrator of either of them or their assigns. may so soon thereafter as they or either of them may choose seize said negroes and after giving twenty days notice of the time & place of sale sell the same or as many thereof as may be necessary to pay & satisfy the Amount due on said notes. the Expenses of this Conveyance and said sale. at the Court House door of said County and Out of the proceeds pay & satisfy the same the Excep if any shall pay over to me.
